### **HONG KONG**

# General

After long postpone, Hong Kong, Singapore travel bubble will resume on May 26. Hong Kong will require pax have to make sure they have received their second vaccine dose 2 weeks before departing for Singapore. Under the arrangement, one designated flight carrying 200 pax will be allowed from each side daily to begin with.

# **MAURITIUS**

# **General**

Mauritius will open their boarders after 15 May. But if the pax has visited S. Africa, Reunion, Mayotte or Brazil in last 15 days won't be allowed to inbound. For those who haven't been to above mentioned places, they have to bring a PCR test result with them and they have to spend 14 days in quarantine. PCR test result is required for crew too and they need to isolate in their hotel during their stay there.

### **NORTH AMERICA**

### **CANADA**

# General

As the COVID pandemic rapidly spreads across India at an alarming rate, Canada has now banned flights from both India and Pakistan as seen in NOTAM G0438/21. As is the usual case with these COVID bans Medical, Cargo, Ferry, and Tech stops without the disembarkation of passengers are exempt from the ban.

### **USA**

# General

As of April 2021, the CDC has issued new policies that allow "fully vaccinated passengers" to travel domestically without any testing nor need for quarantine. To be considered fully vaccinated two weeks must have passed since the final dose of an approved vaccine has been administered. However the guidelines/restrictions for entry of international travelers remain in place UFN and no testing exemption for vaccinated passenger presently exist. The FAA have recently extended its warning for Sinai Peninsula overflights. Along with other Countries the FAA are advising against overflights below FL260, in addition to advice not to operate into any Airports in the region. This extension is until March 30<sup>th</sup> 2022, when the advice will be reviewed.

The FAA has extended its airspace warning for Afghanistan for another 12 months. The advice remains, when operating in the Kabul FIR (OAKX) stick to the airways and maintain FL330 or higher. If you have to land, keep the ground time to a minimum.
