ASIA

JAPAN

RJBB/Osaka

Osaka will be hosting the G20 summit from 28-29 June. During this period, the Airport will not be accepting any GA/BA flights unless you are participating in the G20. In addition, RJBB will not be accepting any diversions during these dates, so please do not select as an alternate.

PACIFIC

AUSTRALIA

General

General – Australia now requires a Transport Security Program (TSP) for all BA/GA flights. Several local handling agents have stated that they can assist with the application. Reference: https://www.homeaffairs.gov.au/transportsecurity/files/aircraft-operator-tsp-guidance.pdf

FIJI

NFNA/Nausori Intl

Airport is closed daily between 0900-1700 UTC from May 27th thru June 01 for runway repair.

SOUTH AMERICA

BRAZIL

General

The Copa America soccer tournament will be taking place in Brazil this coming June/July (14 June through 07 July). The matches will be held in 5 cities across the country. During this time, the following Airports will be implementing slot and PPR requirements at various different times.

SBSP, SBGR,SBMT, SBGL, SBRJ, SBJR, SBBH, SBCF, SBPA, SBSV.

For full details see the NOTAMs or check with the handler

ARGENTINA

General

National strike in Argentina on 29 May 2019. Government services such as ATC and Customs are planned to be impacted. Avoid flight planning in the FIR as well as operation into and out of the country.

CURACAO

General

When overflying the TNCF FIR, Navigation fees must be prepaid in advance to avoid possible rejection of flight plan from Curacao. Reference https://billing.dc-ansp.org/ for payment information.

PERU

SPJC/Jorge Chavez Intl

The airport is closed to all BA/GA during these times:

April 4th until July 31st 2019 from 0100-0400Z AND 1300-1600Z (to reduce airport traffic congestion) June 1st thru June 15th from 0630-0930Z (runway maintenance work)

VENEZULA

General

On May 1st the FAA issued an emergency -DO NOT FLY- NOTAM to all US operators, barring all operations into or over Venezuela, unless operating at or above FL260. NOTAM KICZ A0013/19 issued May 1 2019, 0025Z

General

The Instituto Nacional de Aeronautica Civil (INAC) in Venezuela recently disabled their ITALBANK account which was used by accounts payable departments to make payments for Venezuelan overflight and navigation fees in the past. Operators are now instructed to use a third party source called Jet Man Pay to make these payments to INAC. Local handling agent have stated that they can assist with the payment process thru the use of Jet Man Pay.

NORTH AMERICA

CANADA

CYFB/Iqaluit

Due to very limited fuel quantities for the spring months, Jet A is only available to locally based operators until the beginning of August 2019

CYYR/Goose Bay

Aircraft having a tire pressure of 1.0MPA, an ACN/PN of 40 or higher or a weight over 135 tons are now banned from CYYR UFN due to damage that was incurred to their runways from heavy (airline size) aircraft. NOTAMs may be published latter on when this ban may be lifted once repairs and reinforcement of their runway and taxiways can be made. CYYR is often used by many airline size aircraft as an ETP and as an alternate so operators that cross the North Atlantic should pay particular attention to this closure/ban.

MEXICO

General

An ELT 406 MHZ (Emergency Locator Transmitter) is now required by the Mexican CAA to be installed on board all aircraft operating within the Mexican FIR. Ramp inspections will enforce this new requirement in Mexico. Note that these transmitters are not a requirement in US airspace nor Canada.

RUSSIA

ULLI/St Petersburg

06th June to 08th June, Saint Petersburg will be hosting the annual International Economic Forum. During the period 03rd June 2100Z to 09th June 2100Z there will be heavy slot restrictions along with limited parking availability and high demand for services at ULLI International Airport. In order to secure, the required services please give the handlers as much notice as possible and plan accordingly.

TURKEY, EASTERN EUROPE, AND CENTRAL ASIA

LTBJ/Izmir

Runway and taxiway works continue with RWY 34L/16R being used as a taxiway from Apr 15 to Jul 12. There are multiple runway exits for landing aircraft which are outlined via Notam.

AFRICA

FWCL/Blantyre Chileka

From 23 April through 23 July, Runway 10/28 will be closed for maintenance. The shorter Runway (15/33) will be operational during daylight hours, in VMC conditions.

<u>Libya – General</u>

Flights are prohibited in the north-west part of the country (between 11-16 degrees East, and 30-34 degrees North), and any aircraft departing from HLLT, HLZW, HLMS, HLLM, HLGD and HLLS airports will be denied landing in Malta. In addition HLLM Airport is closed UFN.

EUROPE AND MIDDLE EAST

EUROPE

LFPB - Paris Le Bourget - 2019 Paris International Airshow

Paris International Airshow 2019 - 12th-23rd June - Restrictions, closures and procedures

Airport (LFPB) closure schedule -

```
12th – 20th June, 1130z – 1430z daily
21st - 23rd June, 1030z – 1530z daily.
```

Restrictions on arrivals and departure are in place 30 minutes prior, and 30 minutes post closure times.

Accreditation required for operations during the following dates and times -

```
12th June – 16th June 0700Z - 1530Z.
17th June – 23rd June 0600Z - 1730Z.
```

Refer to the AIP Supplement and Closure Schedule for full details. These Documents give full explanation of the accreditation procedure for aircraft and crew, the closures and restrictions, all relevant information on filing flight plans.

LFPB - Paris Le Bourget Cont...

Paris Le Bourget Airport will be fully closed for <u>all traffic, including medical flights</u>, due to night works. All times **UTC**.

July:

- From Monday, July 29 at 20:00 to Tuesday, July 30 at 03:00
- From Tuesday, July 30 at 20:00 to Wednesday, July 31 at 03:00
- From Wednesday, July 31, 20:00 to Thursday, August 01 03:00

August:

- From Thursday 01 August 20:00 to Friday 02 August 03:00
- From Monday 05 August 20:00 to Tuesday 06 August 03:00
- From Tuesday 06 August 20:00 to Wednesday 07 August 03:00
- From Wednesday 07 August 20:00 to Thursday 08 August 03:00
- From Thursday 08 August 20:00 to Friday 09 August 03:00

During this closure, Pontoise Airport / LFPT will be equipped with a technical marking and a H24 fire rescue presence.

LFMQ/Le Castellet - French F1 Grand Prix

21 – 23 June the French Grand Prix and Qualifying will be held just outside Le Castellet Airport in the South of France. Please expect parking restrictions and limited hotel availability in the area. In addition, services at the Airport will be at a premium during this time. The DGCA have also implemented three temporary restricted areas and Aerodrome use restrictions from 0500Z/20 June through to 1000Z/24 June. AIP Sup 145/19 refers. WWW.SIA.AVIATION-CIVILE.GOUV.FR

ENBR/Bergen Norway

Airport Construction and repair work is set to continue through to 14th June. The airport will be closed overnight between 2200-0400Z Sunday through Thursday; outside of those times, the runway will be operational but with reduced lengths. See AIP SUP 8/19 for further information.

LMML/Malta

Operators intending to operate in HLLLFIR airspace are requested to pre-notify the Malta Airspace Cell on email: airspace.cell@maltats.com

LHBP/Budapest

The Airport will ban flight operations between 0001-0500L (2200-0300Z) starting in August 2019. The only exemption to the ban will be for "exceptional situations" such as emergencies and search and rescue flights.

LFSB/Basel

Operational restrictions are in place between 9-15 June due the Art Basel show. Parking is limited to one hour and all flights must have ground handling confirmed prior to arrival.

LEMD/Madrid

The Champions League final takes place in Madrid on 01st June. CFMU are drawing attention to the following NOTAMS:

A3205/19 FPL planning of LEMD as an alternative airport for general aviation and business aircraft is not allowed without prior authorization from airport manager.

A3201/19 refueling supply for Aircraft operating ad-hoc flights to the UEFA Champions League final not guaranteed.

Above NOTAMs are valid 30 May through 03 June 2019.

EGCC/Manchester

Due to ongoing construction work, Manchester Airport will not be accepting any diversion flights until 31st July at 2359Z. The only caveat is emergency flights, which will still be accepted during this period.

Scotland/General

ATC are planning to strike again at airports across the Scottish Highlands and islands, this time on the 12th June. During the last Strike back in May six airports were forced to close for the day: EGPL/Benbecula, EGPN/Dundee, EGPE/Inverness, EGPA/Kirkwall, EGPO/Stornoway and EGPB/Sumburgh.

MIDDLE EAST

OMDW/Dubai Al Maktoum

Every Monday between 1100Z-1400Z & 2000Z-2045Z Runway 12/30 closed due to Maintenance. Check NOTAMS for updates. Restriction in force from 03 June through 01 July 2019.

PAKISTAN

General

Restrictions are still in place for operations into/out of and transiting Pakistan Airspace. Full details can be found in NOTAM A0580/19 and A0582/19. Current restrictions will remain in place until 14th June 2359Z at the earliest, but expect this to be extended.

GENERAL

GENERAL RESTRICTIONS/REGULATIONS

FAA/EASA advisories and restrictions remain in place for operations into, out of, and over the following countries and their associated FIRs.

SYRIA, AFGHANISTAN, UKRAINE, SOMALIA, ETHIOPIA, SUDAN, EGYPT (SINAI PENINSULA), LIBYA, RUSSIA, VENEZUELA.
