ASIA

CHINA

ZSSS/ZSPD Shang Hai Intl

China International Import Expo (CIIE) will be held in Shanghai during 05-10 Nov 2019. For flights operating into ZSPD or ZSSS during 01-13Nov 2019, CAAC will only accept landing permits & slot applications of business/private jets that will attend CIIE, with sponsor letters issued by CIIE committee. The alternative options for non-CIIE flights wanting to operate into Shanghai during this period may be limited. Possible options are, ZSHC/Hangzhou, ZSNJ/Nanjing and ZSNV/Ningbo, but parking is filling up quickly there. Shanghai ACC has published a NOTAM as follows:

ZGHA/ Changsha Intl

Overnight parking is not available from Nov 2019 to Jan 2020 due to GA ramp construction, only short turnaround will be accepted

JAPAN

General

The Tokyo Olympics will take place between July 24th - August 9th 2020, (the Paralympics are from August 25th September 6th). Operators need to be thinking about their requirements very soon. Special Co-Ordination will start from 1st of December 2019 till 10th of Feb 2020 for the submission of Non-Scheduled flights into the Tokyo Airports.

THAILAND

VTBD/Don Mueang Intl

Parking spots for GA/BA flights at VTBD are limited during 01-05 Nov 2019, due to 35th ASEAN Summit and Related Summits. Operators can do drop and go at VTBD and reposition to VTBU which is only 3 hours away by driving or check with handler is VTBD hangar available or not.

INDIA

VOCL/Calicut India

The airport plans to close for runway repairs daily between 13-18 local time for a period of four months, starting from the last week of October.

VABB/Mumbai India

Delays Five months of misery expected at Mumbai due to daytime closures of the main runway, and now they have published a Notam saying that this will start a week earlier than previously planned. So the main runway (RWY 09/27) will be closed for repairs from Nov 1 to Mar 28 between 0930-1730 local time (4-12z) daily, Mondays to Saturdays. The second runway will be operational during this time, but heavy delays expected.

SINGAPORE

WSSS/Singapore and WSSL/Seletar airports

Both airports will be closed between 1115-1145L (0315-0345z) on Oct 9 and Oct 16, due to military exercise Bersama Lima. At WSSS, the only slots currently available on these dates are after 13L. And remember, WSSS has a standing rule that GA/BA are only allowed to operate between 10-18L (02-10Z) daily, and these must be quick turnarounds - no parking possible.

MACAU

VMMC- Macau

Macau Airshow Nov 1- 3 2019, Please ensure all NOTAMS are checked as airspace restrictions may apply during these dates TPS will be updated with any new restrictions we learn of for this area Parking may be limited for aircraft not participating in the airshow. TAG FBO has stated that they will be able to obtain badges for passengers and crew wishing to see the airshow.

MALAYSIA

General

All airlines intending to overfly Malaysia's airspace as well as operate scheduled and non-scheduled commercial flights to/from Malaysia, are required to obtain overflight/landing permits via the AeroFile portal <https://www.mavcom.my/en/industry/aerofile-registration/>. For commercial landing, a Foreign Air Operator Certificate (FAOC) is required. For commercial overfly, FAOC is not required.

NORTH AMERICA

CANADA

General

On October 10th NAV CANADA transitioned to the ICAO NOTAM format. As a result, NAV CANADA now distributes all Canadian domestic NOTAMs using the ICAO format under new NOTAM Series. NOTAMs obtained directly from a NAV CANADA website are accessed through Collaborative Flight Planning Services (CFPS) instead of the Aviation Weather Web Site (AWWS) where they were previously found. MEXICO

General

On October 14th the Mexican Cartel CJNG ambushed a police convoy in Michoacán state. 30 gunmen armed with military-style assault rifles attacked five police trucks who were driving to the town of El Aguaje in a convoy carrying 42 police officers. The police officers were serving an arrest warrant to a local drug lord. 13 police officers were killed and 9 were critically wounded in the attack. Authorities have increased security personnel and checkpoints in Michoacán following the attack and travel in the region has been discouraged to foreigners until the drug cartel violence can be properly addressed and stopped.

CENTRAL AMERICA AND CARIBBEAN

HAITI

General – On October 15th, the U.K. Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) issued updated travel advice for Haiti warning against travel to the region due to sporadic violent demonstrations, protests and roadblocks in Port au Prince and throughout Haiti.

SOUTH AMERICA

ECUADOR

General – On October 15th, the U.K. Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) issued a warning against travel to Ecuador. The FCO stated that with the current state of violent protests and demonstrations only essential travel should be made to Ecuador. The warning does not apply to the following airports in Ecuador: SEQM, SEQU, SEGU, and SEGS

BRAZIL

SBGR/Guarulhos-Gov Andre Franco Montoro Intl - All aircraft should use covers on the pitot tubes and other crucial openings when on the ground at SBGR as insects have caused blockages resulting in aborted takeoffs. Multiple aborted takeoffs have been reported in 2019 due to this problem.

SBKP/Campinas Brazil – On October 17th an attempted robbery at the cargo terminal of SBKP where men tried to enter a UPS B767. 2 security officers were shot and injured in the robbery and the main road to SBKP was blocked by the attackers. SBGR has also been targeted recently by thieves as the airport had armed assailants steal \$40 million dollars in gold and precious metals and kidnapped 2 airport workers this past July.

RUSSIA

ULLI/St Petersburg

From the 01st October 2019 Russian authorities have launched an eVisa system for St Petersburg Airport. National of 53 foreign states can now apply for an eVisa online, when planning to enter Russia through ULLI Airport. The eVisa is free, and allows entry for stays of up to 8 days. INDIA

VABB/Mumbai

Work on Runway 09/27 which was planned to start on November 01st has now been delayed due to the Monsoon rains. The closure of Runway 09/27 between 0930-1730L (0400-1200Z) daily from Monday through Saturday will now start on the 4th November and run through until 28th March.

AFRICA

Libya – General

Flights are prohibited in the north-west part of the country (between 11-16 degrees East, and 30-34 degrees North), and any aircraft departing from HLLT, HLZW, HLMS, HLLM, HLGD and HLLS airports will be denied landing in Malta. In addition HLLM Airport is closed UFN.

Operators intending to operate in HLLLFIR airspace are requested to pre-notify the Malta Airspace Cell on email: airspace.cell@maltats.com

London Luton Airport will be closed overnight for two weekends in November 2019; as a result the below closures will be enforced.
