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ASIA

CHINA

ZBAA/Beijing Capital Intl

Since COVID19 outbreak, to obtain ZBAA landing permit is becoming difficult. Beijing Winter Olympic Game will hold during 4-20 Feb 2022. If it is VIP government flight associated with Winter Olympic Game, it might be helpful to get ZBAA landing permit. However Chinese government hasn't issue detailed policy to support Winter Olympic Game related flights yet. If flight obtains landing permit into ZBAA, crew will be allowed to stay overnight in Beijing as long as they hold valid crew visa.

NORTH AMERICA

USA

General

On 25 October 2021, President Biden signed a proclamation, enacting new vaccine requirements for foreign nationals arriving in the United States. The US government will lift the country's existing COVID-19-related ban on travel by nonresident foreign nationals entering from the 26 Schengen Area European nations, as well as the U.K., Ireland, India, South Africa, Brazil, Iran, and China (excluding Hong Kong and Macau) effective Nov 8th 2021. Additionally international travelers from all destinations will be required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Only vaccines approved by the USFDA or WHO will be accepted. Nonresident foreign nationals who are not fully vaccinated will not be allowed to enter the US, except for those under the age of 18, people with medical, humanitarian or emergency exceptions, foreign government officials, and people with valid visas traveling from countries with limited vaccine availability. Additionally, all travelers aged two years or older, including US citizens and residents, must present a negative result from a COVID-19 PCR or antigen test. Effective Nov. 8, fully vaccinated travelers must take the test within three days before their departure for the country, while unvaccinated travelers, including US citizens, must take the test within one day before their travel.

Alternatively, travelers can present proof of having recovered from COVID-19 within the previous 90 days. Fully vaccinated travelers will be allowed to enter the US through the country's land and maritime borders with Canada and Mexico for nonessential purposes starting Nov. 8. Persons traveling for essential reasons have been exempted from restrictions to date; however, from January 2022, they too will also be required to be fully vaccinated and show proof of such vaccination to enter the country.

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EUROPE

IRELAND

Cork Airport is closed from September 13 to November 22 2021 for major runway repairs. Please plan accordingly.

UNITED KINGDOM

General

The COP 26 summit is taking place in Scotland from Oct 30 to Nov 12. During this time you can expect heightened security at the following Airports, all of which will be accommodating COP 26 traffic. EGPH/Edinburgh, EGPK/Prestwick and EGPF/Glasgow. All of these Airports may all experience delays during peak hours due to increased traffic leaves and security procedures. AIC M091/2021 contains the full information on airspace restrictions and hours.

SWITZERLAND

General

Advanced planning reminder for 2022. The World Economic Forum will take place in Davos from Jan 17 -22. During this time parking at Airports in the region will be restricted. Handlers and Airport Authorities are recommending operators to think about organizing parking and handling as soon as possible as space and services will be at a premium during the event. LSZH/Zurich and FDH/EDNY are both Airports to consider.

AFRICA

ETHIOPIA

General

Reminder Caution - HAAB/Addis FIR have published a Notam closing a section of airspace below FL290 over the Tigray region along the Ethiopia/Eritrea border in the north of the country. This follows reports that militia shot down a military transport plane in the region last week near the capital Mekele.

The conflict appears to be escalating again. Caution should be used if overflying the area, particularly on airways UM656/UT124 between the HSSS/Khartoum and HAAA/Addis FIRs which have previously been closed due to the conflict.

MIDDLE EAST/INDIA

AFGHANISTAN

General

The FAA has extended its airspace warning for Afghanistan for another 12 months. The advice remains, when operating in the Kabul FIR (OAKX) stick to the airways and maintain FL330 or higher. If you have to land, keep the ground time to a minimum.
