NORTH AMERICA

USA

General

Atlantic Aviation continues to expand its FBO network. Early this year Atlantic combined forces with Ross Aviation. Atlantic continues to grow its network as it has just recently acquired three former TAC Air FBOs at KOMA, KRDU and KBDL. The combined companies will operate under the Atlantic Aviation brand name. The change over in names of the FBO's and signage is likely to take some time so be prepared for name changes in the coming months and changes in contact info as the mergers and acquisitions are finalized.

Atlantic has grown in size to over 100 FBOs spanning across North America, Hawaii and the Caribbean.

KDRO/Durango-La Plata Co

Runway resurfacing has been scheduled for September 7th until the 16th and where the airport will be closed to all traffic during this timeframe

KMFR/Medford

The Rogue Valley airport will be closed for repairs starting 12am on Sept 13 to 9am on Sept 14th and will also be closed from midnight to 5am on weekdays all September 2022.

CANADA

General

The NBAA has recently received reports of potential delays for flights to Canada when persons are trying to call CANPASS for approval prior to departure. It may be possible to expedite the process for USA Pre-Approved travelers if they sign up for the "Corporate Aircraft /Private Aircraft" programs. Renewals for these programs have been extended to October 1st 2022 for permits that expired during the pandemic. For further information on this refer to the NBAA report:

CYUL/Montreal

A large ICAO aviation conference will occur this year in Montreal from the 27th of September until the 7th of October. FBO's have reported that parking may become an issue if the attendance is as high as anticipated so it is recommended to call the FBOs prior to making plans on flying into CYUL during this timeframe

CYYZ/Toronto Pearson

Toronto will host its annual airshow September 3rd thru the 5th. The International Air Show will have aerial displays 12pm to 3pm local local each day of the event.

CARRIBEAN

CAYMAN ISLANDS

General

Starting August 24th 2022 the Cayman Islands will lift all remaining Covid travel restrictions and items such as mandated face mask wearing, pre-travel testing, proof of vaccination and declarations are not required for entry to the country.

EUROPE

General

As the summer season starts kick in a number of European Countries are facing strikes, affecting both ground handling, Fire Services and ATC. Please keep a close eye on the CFMU NOP and Notams for full details.

General

A number of European Countries, and the U.K, are planning Military exercises throughout September. Currently the U.K, Turkey, France and Spain all have some planned. Generally, these will only result in low operational impact, but will include some Airspace closures. Please monitor NOTAMs and the CFMU NOP for the latest, and check flight plan routings carefully.

MIDDLE EAST

LLBG/Tel Aviv Israel

Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport is banning all 4 engine aircraft. These regulations, will come into force on the 31 Mar 2023. The Airport Authority have specifically called out the Boeing 747 and A380s, apparently for environmental and noise reasons, however we recommend if you plan to operate any other four engine Aircraft after this date, it may be prudent to double check with the CAA or Airport before the regulations hit.

CENTRAL ASIA

UTSS/Samarkand Uzbekistan

The Airport is closed to all flights from September 12-17. Please consider other Airports in the region such as UTTT/Tashkent or UTDD/Dushanbe during this period.

Kazakhstan General

Kazakhstan permission application rules. Due to the changes in the internal CAA structure, we have been advised that the CAA will only give authorization for new or updated landing permit applications Monday through Friday during business hours, 02:00 – 14:00 UTC. They are not authorized to approve applications on Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays.

Please plan your flights accordingly.

UKRAINIAN SITUATION

A number of Airspace closures are in force, together with restrictions on Russian, owners, operators and registered Aircraft. Russia also has it's own set of reciprocal restrictions. See Notams or the below links for up to date information.
